EMOTIONALLY INTELLIGENT TEACHER IS THE NEED OF HOUR

Earlier it was believed that a high IQ is a good predictor to a person's success in life. Later researches conducted in the field of intelligence had revealed that a high IQ only is not Sufficient for success throughout life but social and emotional understanding also play a crucial role during the journey to success in life.



We all know that people with modest IQs who are in their love lives, in raising children, and in maintaining their physical & mental well-being much more successful than many people who have higher IQs. Why do "smart" people think "dumb" and vice versa. Because there is a second kind of intelligence that is unrelated to IQ tests; but is related, instead to common sense, social skills and coping with emotions. It is called emotional intelligence.

Emotional intelligence is the kind of intelligence which deals with the handling of emotions. A person, who can handle his or her emotions with ease is called emotionally intelligent or of a high EQ (Emotional Quotient). The concept of EI was popularized by Daniel Goleman. He defines EI as 'the capacity for recognizing our own feelings and those of others, for motivating ourselves and for managing emotions well in ourselves and in our relationships.'

Teaching is a noble profession and is known as the mother of all professions. The person involved in this profession is known as a teacher. A teacher has to perform many tasks in school but the important one is providing knowledge to students.

An emotionally intelligent teacher will deal with the different categories of students in an appropriate way. He will try to make them understand in an easiest mode which is graspable to them according to their age and mental level. He also will not discriminate among students regarding their gender, academic achievement & socio-economic status etc.

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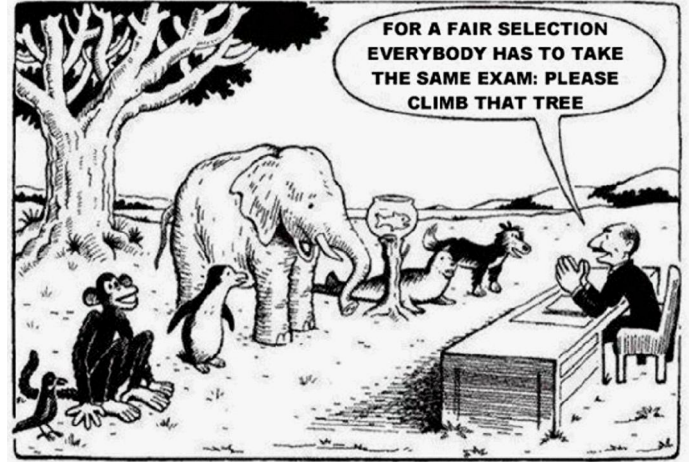
